- Be committed to the program; be involved, reliable, & responsible.



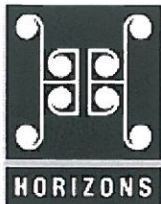

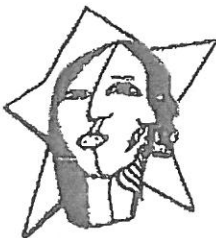
